

Creado con propósitos, recreativos frente al parque, las instalaciones recreativas Hickory Point se estrenó en febrero de 1992. Hoy este parque es integral en la comunidad y es operado por el Lake County Water Authority (LCWA), ofreciendo numerosas actividades y servicios para los visitantes de todas las edades.

Hickory Point es un destino perfecto para un pasadía. Los visitantes pueden disfrutar de la playa de natación, paseos marítimos, áreas de picnic al aire libre con parrillas, áreas de juego de campo abierto, sendero natural, parque infantil, tiro de herradura y cancha de voleibol de arena. Amplio estacionamiento que acomoda tanto automóviles como remolques. El parque tiene doce rampas, dos de los cuales pueden dar cabida a barcos de profundidad incluyendo veleros. Hickory Point ofrece un puerto deportivo de uso diario (no estadia marítima durante la noche, por favor) con dos muelles de pesca y una plataforma de observación. La marina tiene capacidad para barcos de hasta 10' X 30'.

El parque también cuenta con un pabellón de dos pisos con mesas de picnic de primer piso y área para parrilladas. El segundo piso, con conveniente ascensor, ofrece dos áreas de banquetes con mesas y sillas de patio. El pabellón puede dar cabida a grupos pequeños o grandes con reuniones de hasta 275 personas. Los baños se encuentran en ambos niveles. Todas las partes del pabellón pueden ser reservadas hasta un año adelantado para eventos especiales como reuniones, fiestas, quinceañeras, reuniones de clase o torneos de pesca. Los costos varían de entre \$35 y \$295 dependiendo del evento.

About the Park

Created as a unique, recreational, waterfront park, the Hickory Point Recreational Facility premiered in February 1992. Today this comprehensive park, operated by the Lake County Water Authority, provides numerous activities and facilities for guests of all ages.

Hickory Point is a perfect destination for a day's outing. Guests can enjoy the swimming beach, boardwalks, outdoor picnic areas with barbecue grills, open-field play areas, nature trail, playground, and horseshoe pits.

Ample parking accommodates cars and boat trailers. The park has twelve boat ramps; two can accommodate deep-draft vessels including sailboats, and two can accommodate kayaks and canoes.

Hickory Point offers a day-use marina (no overnight mooring, please) with an observation platform and two fishing piers. The marina accommodates boats up to 10' X 30'.

The park also features a two-story, screened picnic pavilion with first-floor picnic tables and barbecue grills. The second floor, with convenient elevator access, offers two screened banquet rooms with round tables and patio chairs. The pavilion can accommodate small groups or larger gatherings of up to 275 people. Restrooms are located on both levels.

All or part of the pavilion, as well as additional park facilities, may be reserved up to a year in advance for meetings, reunions, weddings, fishing tournaments, etc. For reservations or more information, please call the Lake County Water Authority at 352-324-6141.

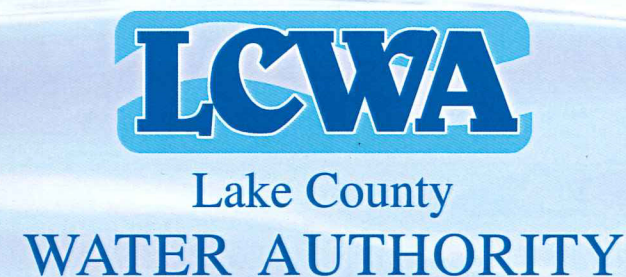

The Lake County Water Authority's 68-acre Hickory Point Recreational Facility is located on the shore of Little Lake Harris at the north end of the Howey Bridge, State Road 19, approximately four miles south of Tavares.

For the enjoyment and safety of all our visitors, we ask that you read and follow these park regulations:

- No Overnight Camping or Boat Mooring
