GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT ADMINISTRATION OF COSTS

No refund shall be given on any permits \$100 or less unless the permit is issued in error by the County.

No more than 50% of building, electrical, plumbing, fire, gas or mechanical fees shall be refunded.

No refund shall be given on plan review fees or administrative fees.

For residential projects, the minimum permit fee is required at the time of application. This fee is non-refundable. This fee will be credited to the Building Permit Fee if permit is obtained before expiration of the application.

For commercial projects, one-half of the permit fee is required at the time of application. This fee is non-refundable. This fee will be credited to the Building Permit Fee if permit is obtained before expiration of the application.

Refunds will be returned to the individual or entity that made the original payment

No refund shall be given on permits over one hundred eighty (180) days old from date of issuance or if construction has been started unless the permit is issued in error by the County.

Expiration. Every permit issued shall become invalid unless the work on the site authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after its issuance, or if the work authorized on the site by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of one hundred eighty (180) days after the time the work is commenced. The Building Official is authorized to grant, in writing, one or more extensions of time, for periods not more than ninety (90) days each. The extension shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated.

No refund shall be given on any permits \$100 or less unless the permit is issued in error by the County.

No more than 50% of building, electrical, plumbing, fire, gas or mechanical fees shall be refunded.

No refund shall be given on plan review fees or administrative fees.

Refunds shall only be released to the property owner unless otherwise stated in written notarized notification from the property owner that the refund can be released to someone else.

No refund shall be given on permits over one hundred eighty (180) days old from date of issuance or if construction has been started unless the permit is issued in error by the County.

Building Permits shall become null and void if construction is not started and a valid inspection called for within one hundred eighty (180) days from the issue date. Building Permits are void if work described thereon has not been completed within three hundred sixty-five (365) days from issue date.
